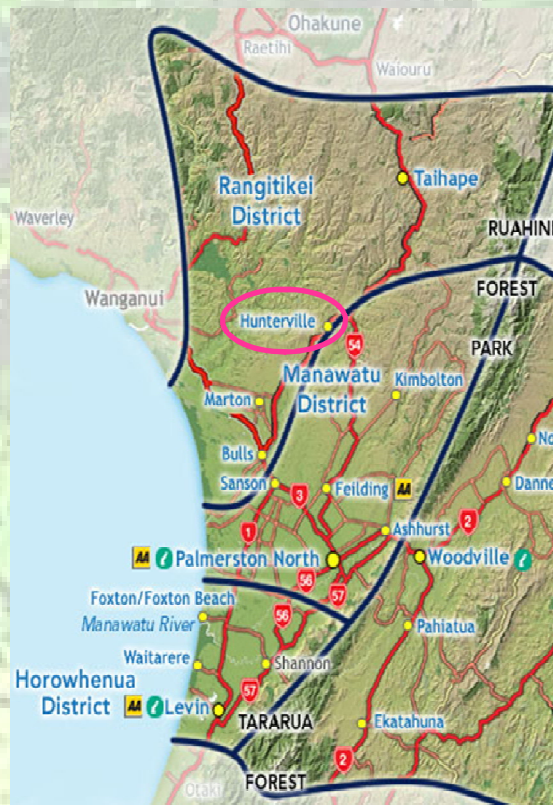

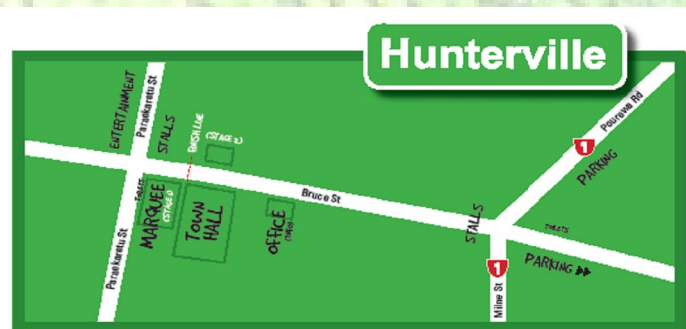

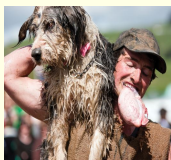

## Hunterville Huntaway Festival 29 October 2011

The 2011 Hunterville Huntaway Festival is on its way and it is time to think once again of entering one of the featured events.

**Shepherds' Shemozzle** - A cross country obstacle race for Shepherds' and their Huntaway Dogs. The exact course is a mystery until the day but will include the water trough, food stop and over, under and through obstacles to compete for the ultimate prize - "Winner of the 2011 Shepherds' Shemozzle". The winner will also have their name engraved on the coveted SBJ Shield.

### *The history of the SBJ (Sure & Be Jesus) Shield,*

*Jack Henery—local identity of Irish extraction, Stockman, Dogman and Drover extraordinaire, liked a tippie, a yarn and a job involving animals and dogs.*

**Dog Barking Challenge** - Our Judge will set challenging tasks for dogs to negotiate down the main street of Hunterville.

**Miss Huntaway** - Beauty show with a difference. Contestants must be good looking maiden Huntaway Bitches. Only those who can strut their stuff on the Cat Walk need apply.

**Shearing Contractors Challenge** - Four Local Shearing Contractor Teams will "Shear Off" for the title "2011 Shemozzle Shearing Contractor Champions" - not your normal speed Shear.

**Childrens' Shemozzle** - The Childrens' Shemozzle is a cross country obstacle race for primary school children 9 years and over. Lots of wonderful prizes are up for grabs and the winner will take home the **James Bull Holdings Challenge Salver**.

## Evening Event

Entry into the **Platinum Homes - McEntee Hire Marquee** during the evening will be restricted to persons wearing a HHF Wrist Band. Wrist Bands can be purchased from the **Young Country Security Kiosk** (outside the Marquee) for \$2.00 and will be available for purchase from 1.00 pm till 8.00 pm.

Photo ID may be required (as proof of age) to purchase a wrist band.  
**(No Photo ID - No Admittance)**

**Under 18's** will only be given access (with wristband) if accompanied and supervised by their legal guardian.

**18's—20's** will be given unlimited access (with wristband) - however any sign of trouble and you will be asked to leave the marquee (with no opportunity to return).

**20's +** will be given unlimited access (with wristband) however we will have security guards in the marquee and anyone causing disruptions in the secure area will be asked to leave.

**No alcohol will be served to minors or intoxicated persons.**

Hunterville Township has recently become an "Alcohol Free" area so any alcohol found on or in the possession of persons outside the Marquee area will be removed and fines may be imposed.

The increased security measures at our event have been put in place to ensure the safety of all who attend our event and the locals who live within our community. These measures have the full support of our Local Council and Police.

**Please remember that our event is not a BYO event.**

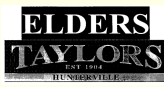
